Gov't cuts oil import tariff

President Arroyo ordered yesterday the reduction of the tariff on petroleum imports in an effort to ease the impact of recordhigh global crude prices on the local economy, particularly on poor Filipinos.

"To address the rising price of oil in the world market, we will implement immediate assistance to the masses," Mrs. Arroyo told a news conference. "We will bring down the tariff on all petroleum products."

The President said the tariff cut will not upset the government's revenue program, unlike the suspension of the 12 percent value-added tax being pushed by some senators.

Finance Secretary Margarito Teves, at the same briefing, said the three percent duty on oil would be cut to two percent, and that further cuts would be made "if crude oil prices stay at \$92 a barrel." He said every percentage reduction in the oil tariff would translate to a pump price cut of 23 to 25 centavos.

But if applied to diesel only, a one-percent tariff cut would mean a reduction in diesel price of 46 centavos per liter.

Teves said the government would meet with officials of local oil firms to discuss whether to apply the scheme **Turn to Page 8**
