'Payola' for FG

Barely had President Arroyo warmed her seat when the first in a series of scandals involving the First Family erupted. Correspondence seretary Veronica "Bing" Rodrigo accused First Gentleman Mike Arroyo of taking a P50million bribe in July 2001
